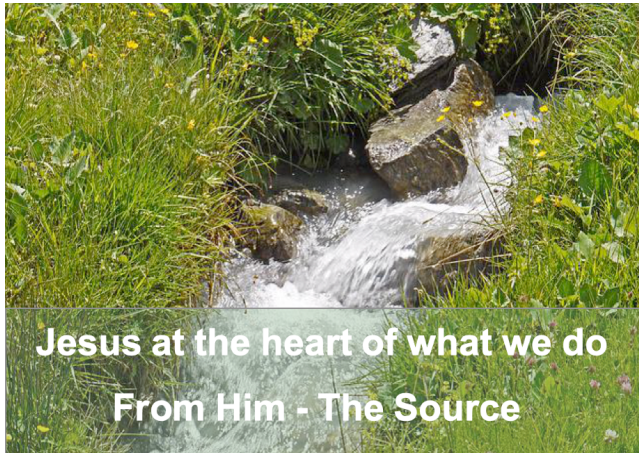

Series: Jesus at the heart of what we do

From Him – The Source

2 Peter 1: 1-4

TODAY’S SERVICE – Today we begin a new four-week series which explores the basis for us as Christians living in today’s world based on Romans 1:36. The intent is to understand how a relationship with God must affect everything that we do in our day to day living. Because only He can provide what we need for life and Godliness, only He can provide a motivation for living which exceeds all others. Only He should be the reason for everything that we do and only He should be the hope beyond this life. If ALL THINGS are to be found in Him there is no room for doubt or fear or powerlessness or despair, but the challenge of the series is to determine what things we hold on to that are not under His control and how in yielding those things up to Him we gain the victory in Christ, and He gains the Glory. What an amazing prospect.

We begin this series as Simon reminds us that every comes “From Him – The source” based on 2 Peter 1:1-4.
