John 7:37-38 & 8:12-20

AN UPDATE ON SIMON – As most of you know, Simon’s had his operation on Tuesday and is now back at home. Secondly, the operation went well and he has already seen an improvement in the movement of his foot. He is however in considerable pain and asks you to pray into that situation. He is also concerned that he is currently unable to carry out the duties his calling demands. We have reassured him that we all understand and will be supporting him all the way. Please pray too that Simon can experience God’s peace as he goes through this difficult time of enforced inactivity from the day-to-day activities at the church. Please all pray for Nicky, Emily and Anaya as they need God’s strength and our support at this very difficult time.
