NEWS FROM THE BIBLE SOCIETY - As you might know our church supports the Bible Society with a substantial gift each year and their news is exciting. In Kuwait , Bahrain, Oman and Dubai **migrant workers** from the poorest countries long for hope and are coming to faith in huge numbers. An awakening is happening across the **Bible Lands** causing an urgent and unmet demand for the Bible, and explosive growth in **China** for the last 40 years means there is now an average of one pastor for every 6,700 Christians and most pastors have not been able to have theological training, so lay pastors need the Study Bibles that the Bible Society provides (each costing the society £13) so that they can be equipped to teach God's word.
